Help Others Register to Vote: Here Are Your Staff Meeting Talking Points

Encouraging others to register to vote at a staff meeting or other gathering couldn't be easier.

First, print out as many [voter registration applications](#) as you need. Or pick up copies at your [County Election Board](#) office or your local post office.

Talking points to guide your discussion:

- Oklahoma's 2010 elections are coming up. The State Legislators and Members of Congress we elect this year will make critical decisions impacting Oklahoma's economy, your pocketbook, and this organizations ability to compete and grow.
- We'll also be electing a new Governor, Lt. Governor, Attorney General, State Superintendent of Schools and others also on the ballot – Really important leaders for our state.
- Oklahoma's July 27th Primary Election is just days away. At that election, you'll vote on who'll represent your political party in our General Election November 2nd.
- **But to vote in the Primary, you must be registered to vote by Friday, July 2nd.**
- Who should register?
 - If you're 18 years old or older and haven't voted before.
 - If you moved and want to vote in your new polling place.
 - If you changed your name and want to vote under your new name.
 - If it's been six years since you last went to the polls.
- I have voter registration application forms here for you – and extras you can take home so your family can register.
- The information you write on your form is private. You can mail it in yourself. Or, if you want, you can put it in the voter registration envelope available at <<COMPANY LOCATION>> with others that will be mailed in together before the deadline.
- *We encourage you to vote on Election Day – but will not tell you how to vote.*
