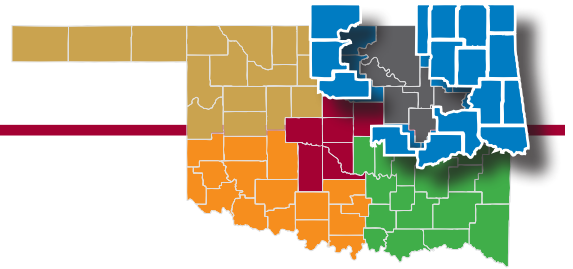
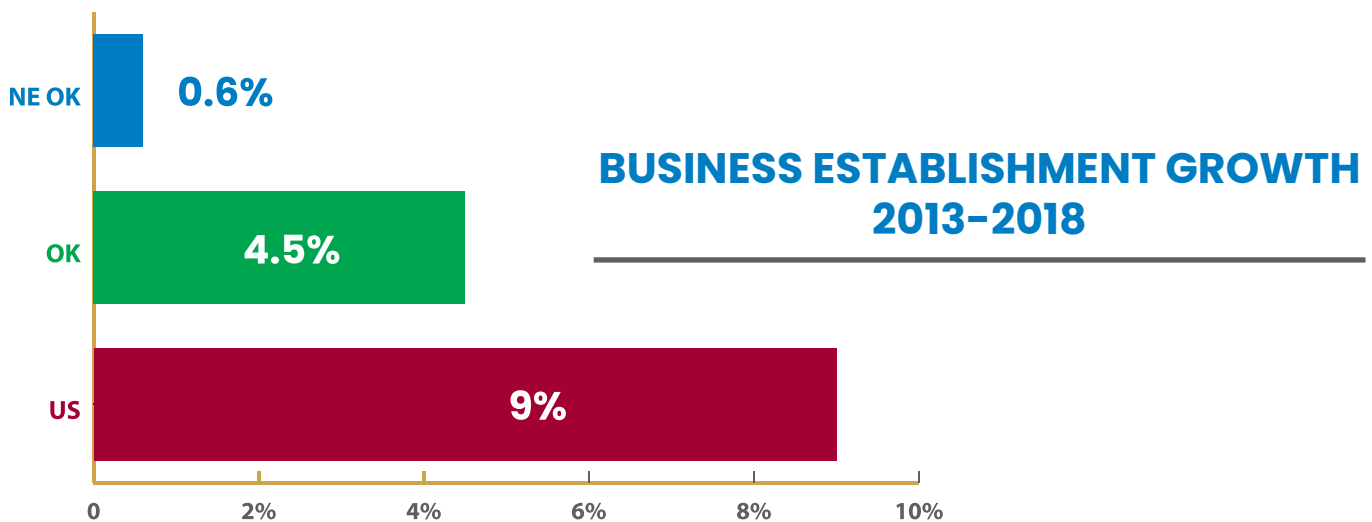


NORTHEASTERN OKLAHOMA



Northeastern Oklahoma made up 13.7% of Oklahoma’s total population in 2018, while making up 9.2% of the state’s total GDP. The Northeast region of the state had the second highest increase of household earnings between 2012 and 2017 with an increase of 11.4%, as well as the second largest decrease in the unemployment rate.

The Northeast region had the highest poverty rate in the state at 21% but had the second highest increase in per capita income growth of all regions. The following tables detail different metrics at the national, state and local level.

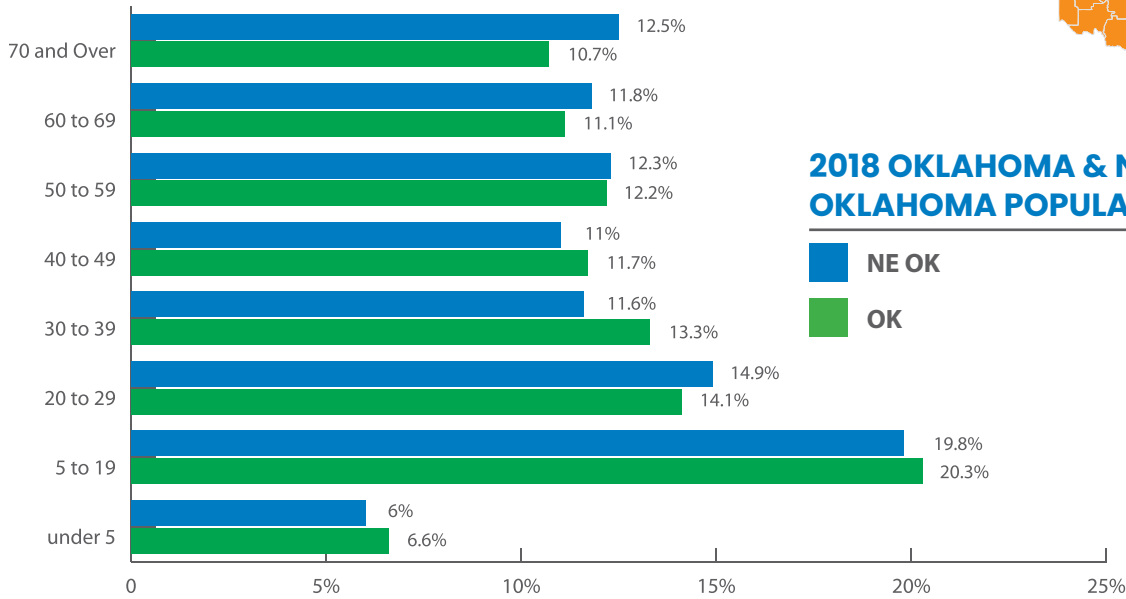
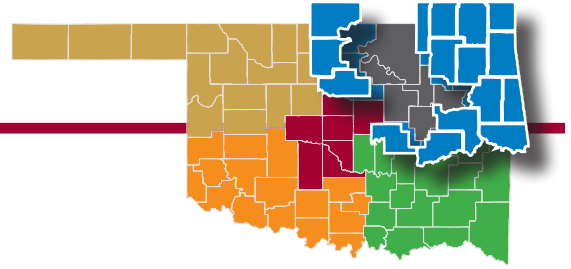

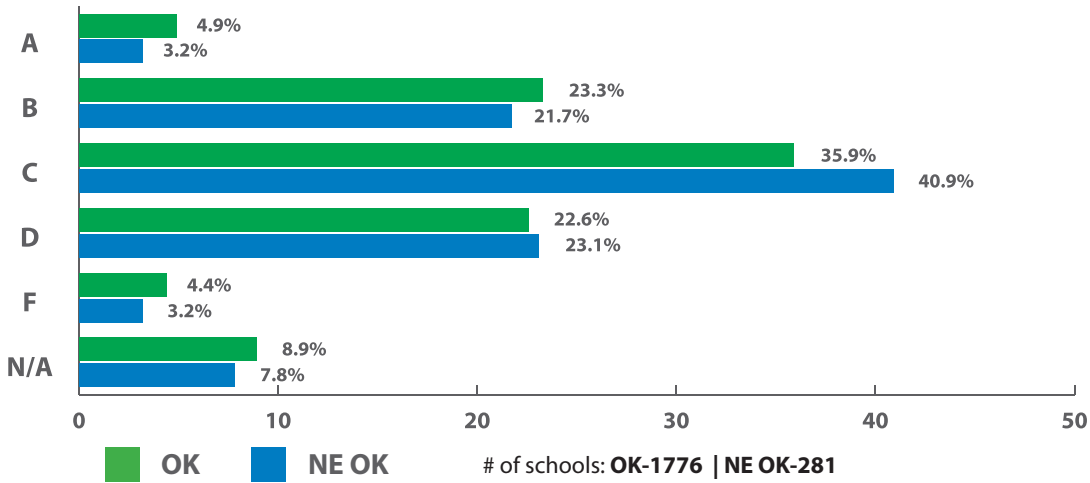
2018 Unemployment Rate
