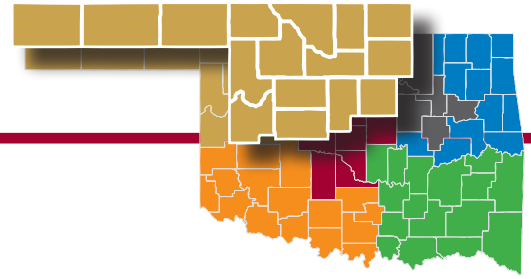
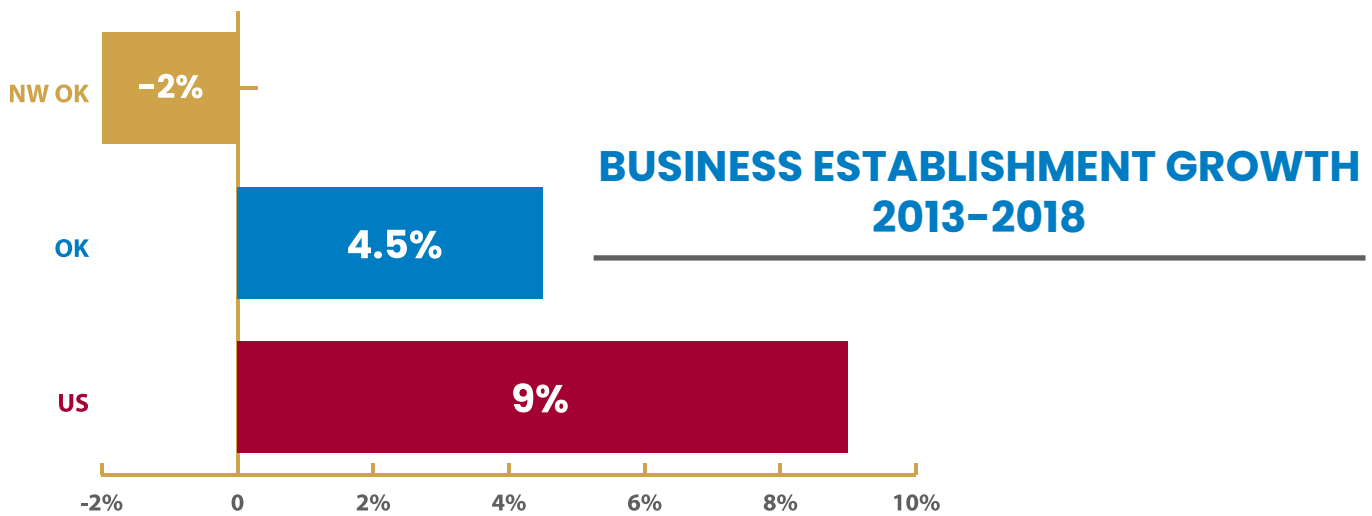


# NORTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA



Northwestern Oklahoma made up 5.2% of Oklahoma’s total population in 2018, while making up 6.0% of the state’s total GDP. The Northwest region of the state also had the largest increase in the share of population with a bachelor’s degree or higher between 2012 and 2017.

Northwestern Oklahoma had the second largest decrease in net migration between 2010 and 2018 but the second smallest decrease in the labor participation rate between 2012 and 2017. The following tables detail different metrics at the national, state and local level.

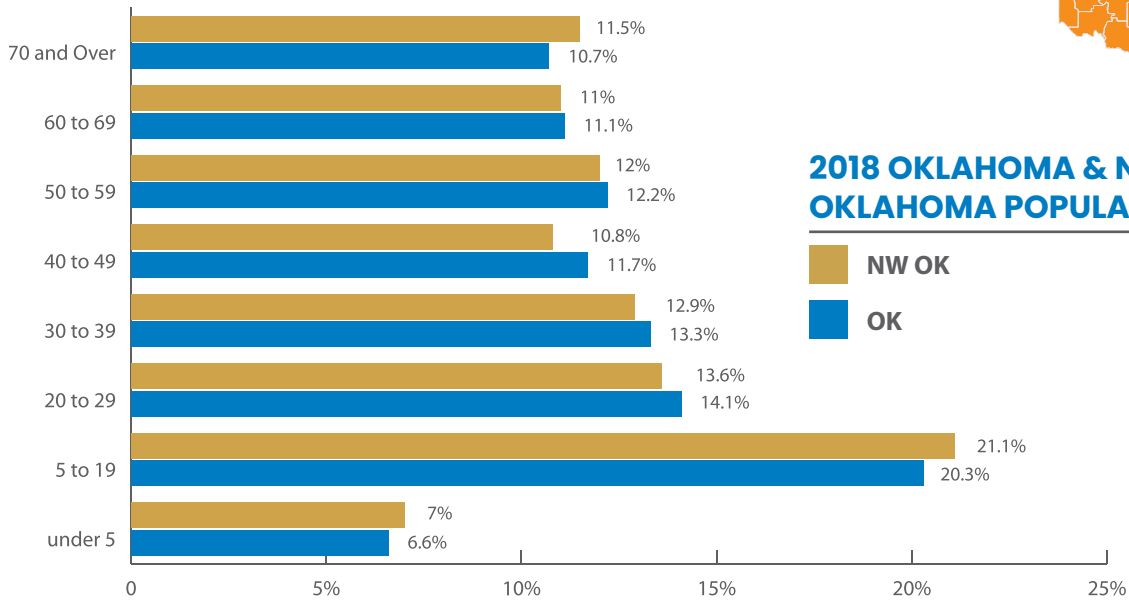
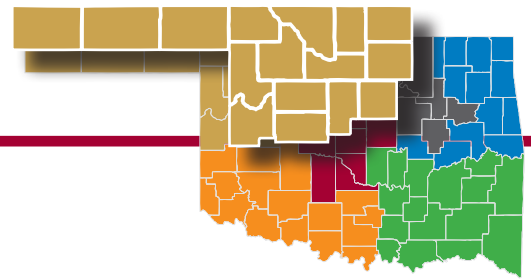

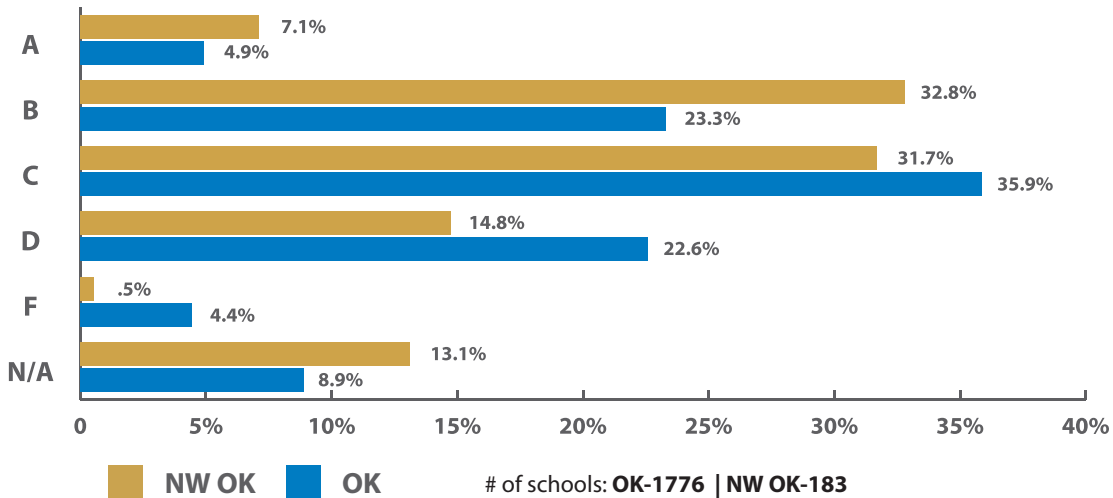
2018 Unemployment Rate
