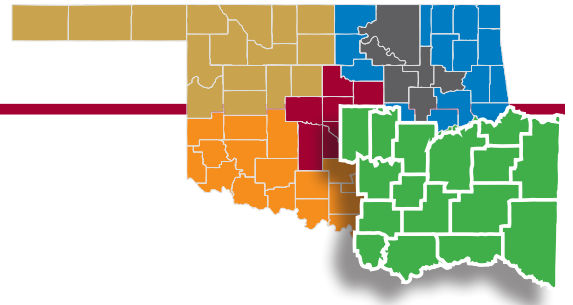
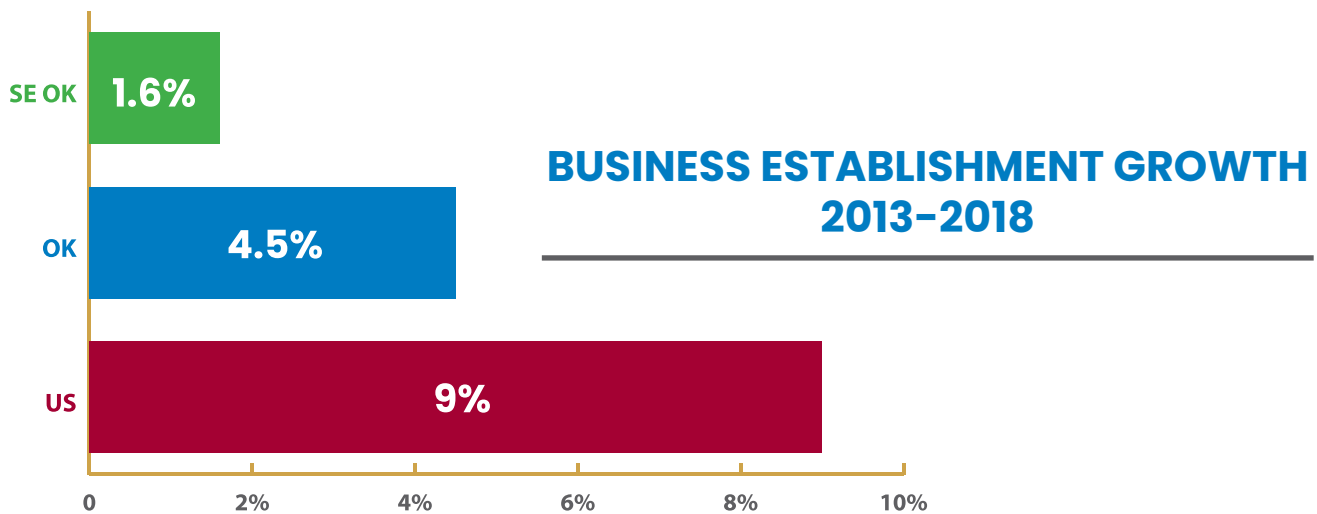


SOUTHEASTERN OKLAHOMA



Southeastern Oklahoma made up 10.6% of Oklahoma’s population in 2018 while making up 6.5% of the state’s total GDP. The Southeast region of the state was the only non-metro region with a positive increase in net migration between 2010 and 2018, as well as the highest percent increase of employment in the non-metro areas between 2013 and 2018.

Southeastern Oklahoma has a role to play in the future of Oklahoma’s non-metro regions across the state and can be a benchmark for others to strive. The following tables detail different metrics at the national, state, and local level.

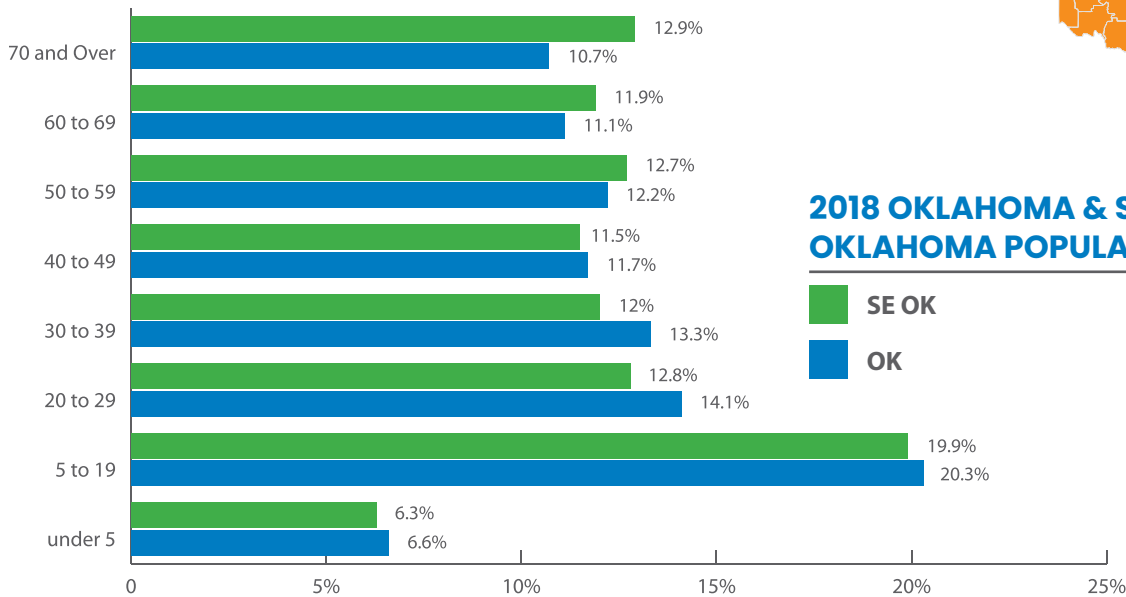
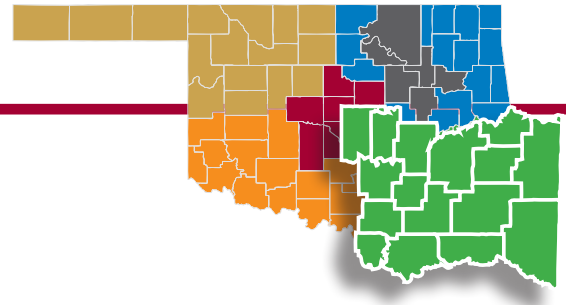
Percent change between 2013 and 2018

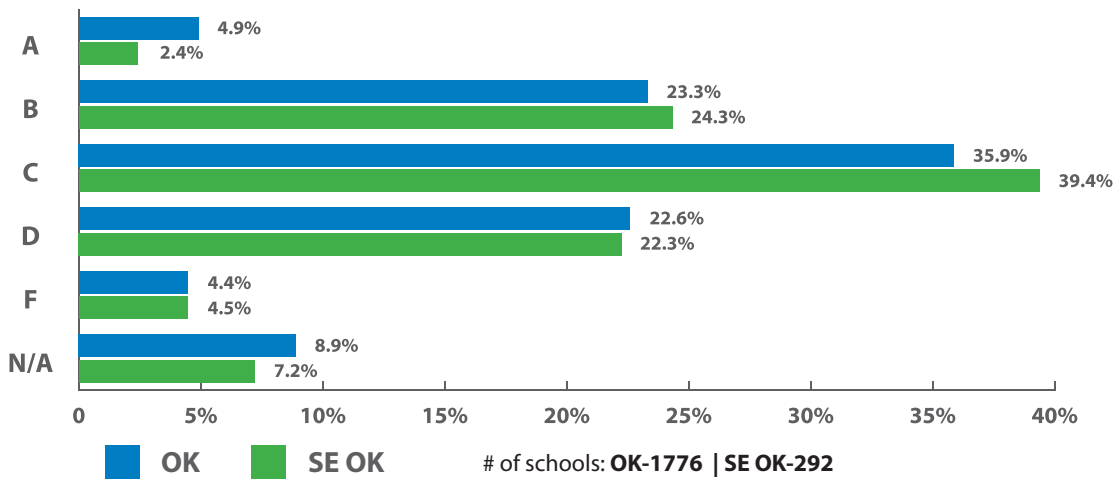
Patents per 100,000 people in 2015
